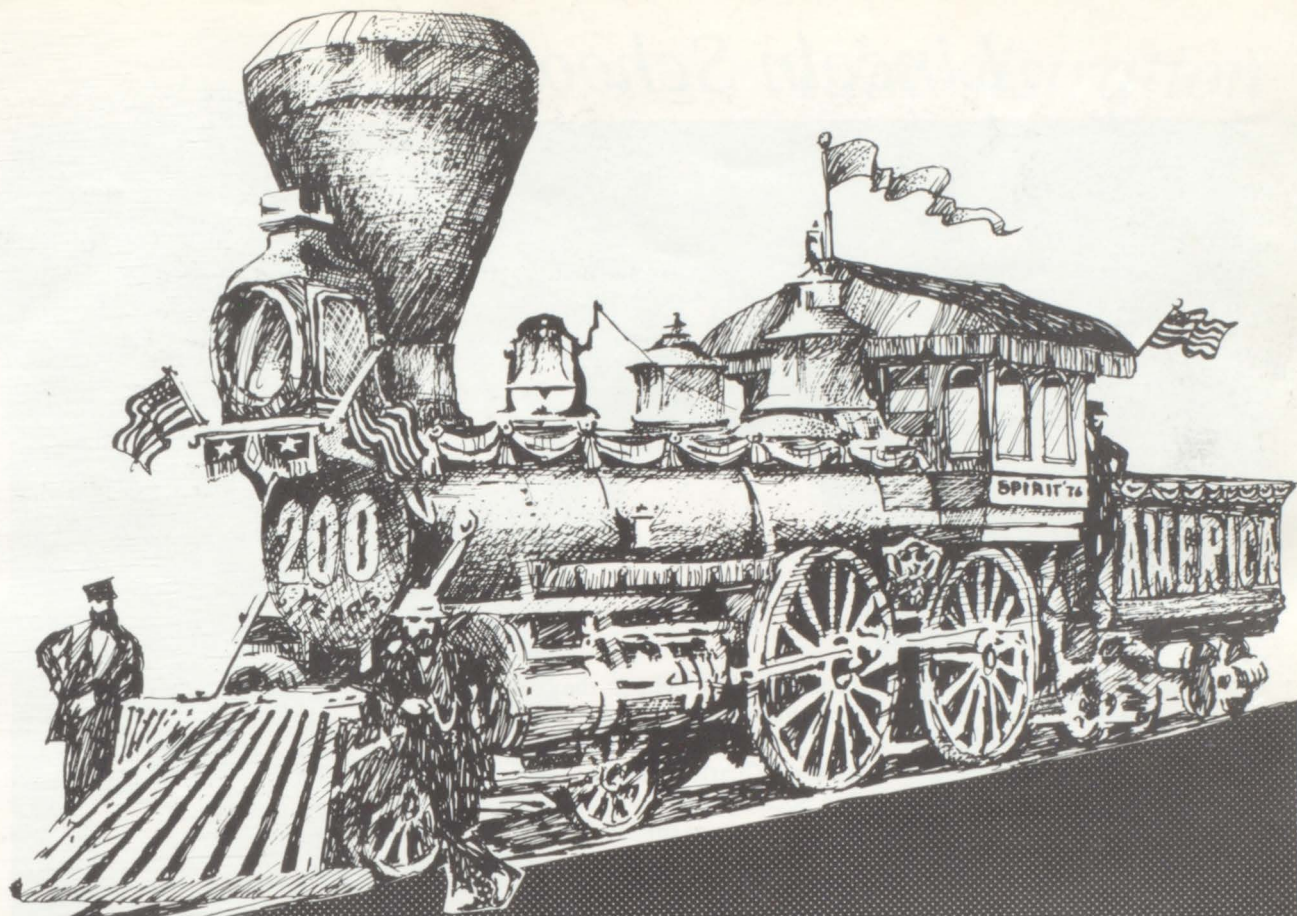
CARL SHOPBELL

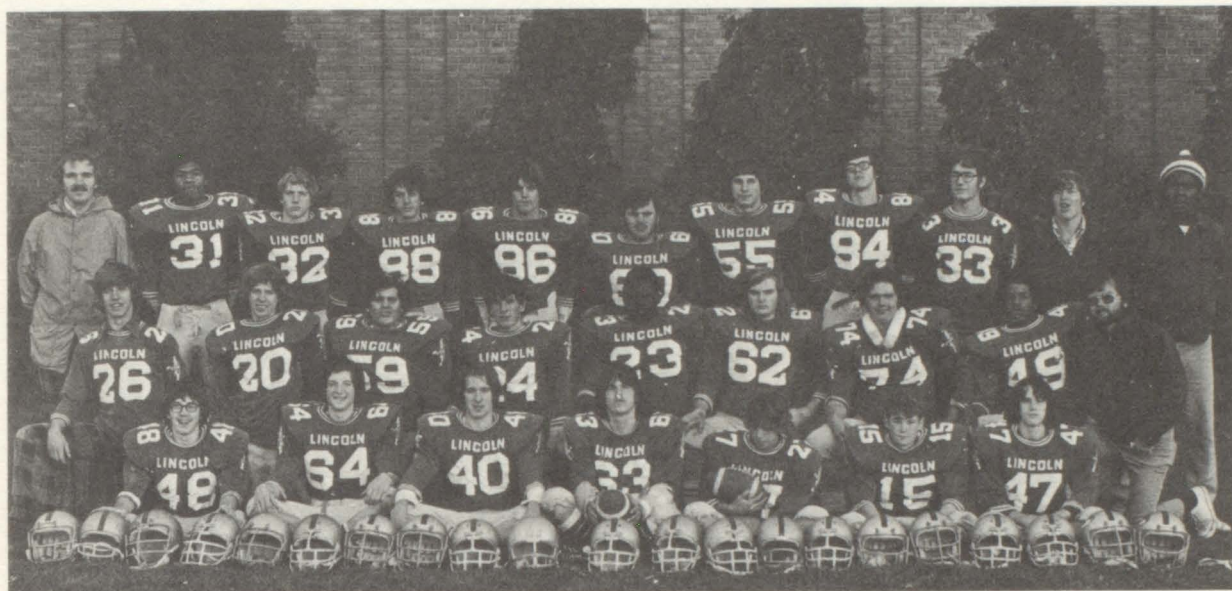
