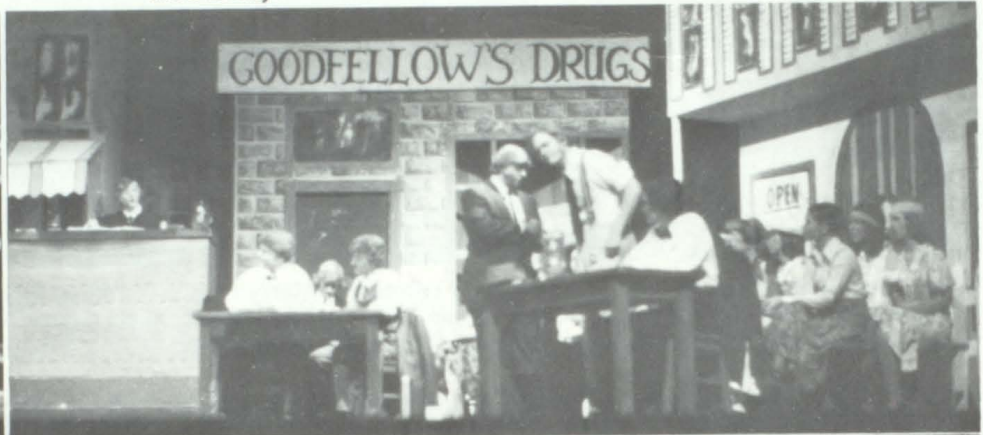
PLAY AND MUSICAL

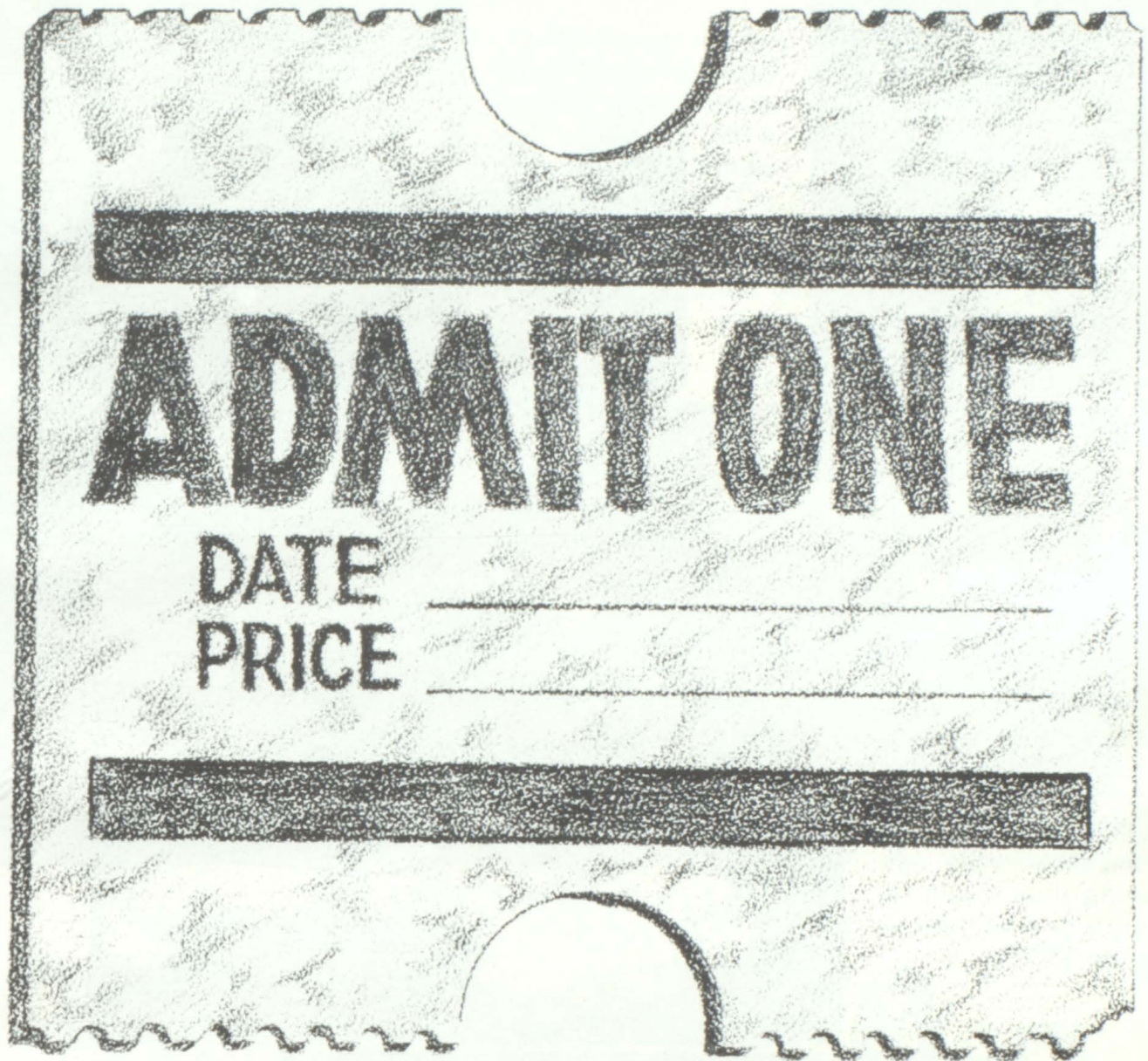
